TRACKING TEST AWARD

A Green Rosette & wooden initial will be given to each handler and dog team that passes the Tracking Dog test.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION; With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test there must be filed an original statement dated within one year and signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests (or Provisional Tracking Judge), certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test.

TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW: This test is limited to 4 TD, 4 TDX & 6 VST dogs. Entries will remain open for TD/TDX TUESDAY, 9/29/09 until 5:00 p.m., and for VST WEDNESDAY, 9/30/09 until 5:00 p.m.. If entries received exceed the test limit, a public drawing will be held WEDNESDAY, 9/30/09, at 6:00 p.m. at BSKD 2980 W. Oxford Ave, Sheridan, Colorado. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to Pembroke Welsh Corgis first, followed by other breeds. If limits for entries are not reached in 1 test area & entries are exceeded in another, the number of tracks may be exchanged at the ratio of 2 TDs for 1 TDX, etc.

ENTRY FEE: \$65.00 – TD; \$100.00 TDX, VST. (This includes the 50 cent AKC recording fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) Make checks payable to PWCCR and send, with TD certification, to the Event Secretary, Ms. Cindy Hutt, PO Box 5128, Denver, CO. 80217-5128.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note" on page 4 of this premium list), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM and write "Tracking" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Entries sent by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** must be marked "no signature required" and **must be sent PO Box to PO Box**. The Test Secretary is not home during the day to sign for special deliveries.

THE ORDER OF RUNNING will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

SPECIAL NOTE: Any exhibitor whose dog passes a TD/TDX/VST test AFTER the closing date for the PWCCR test but BEFORE the running of the test may withdraw their entry and receive full refund of the entry fee PROVIDED that such withdrawal is made by phone, in writing or in person to the Test Secretary **at least 48 hours prior to the test** and FURTHER PROVIDED that alternate exhibitors are available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

PWCCR does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry forms for these events.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The PWCCR assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING OUR TEST SITES: Exhibitors are requested to not practice at the test sites within three days of the test without first contacting the test chairperson to find out which areas may be used. **Exhibitors and spectators are not permitted to park along the Chatfield Park roads.** This is a park rule! Designated drivers will take exhibitors and spectators to drop-off or viewing points.

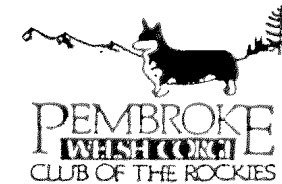

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, ie., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.
